

CERTIFICATION OF SWIMMING POOL FENCING AMENDED FORM 17

Purpose

To advise building certifiers of changes to the mandatory Form 17 concerning the certification of pool fencing.

Background

Pool owners are required to ensure that a complying pool fence is placed around a pool before the pool is intentionally filled with water. They are also required to ensure a building certifier inspects the pool fence and provides a certificate in the "approved form", certifying that the fence satisfies the pool fencing standards. The "approved form" for this purpose is Form 17.

Legislation

On 1 October 2003, *The Building Act Amendment Act 2003* amended the pool fencing requirements of the *Queensland Building Act 1975*. As a result of these amendments Form 17 is amended to reflect the changes.

Changes are editorial in nature to reflect new section numbers, the reference to the "pool owner" as opposed to the "owner", and the Act change that requires the certifier to certify only the fence and not the pool as well.
