## CONVENTIONAL CONTRACT SIGNIFICANT DIFFERENCES BETWEEN VERSIONS DATED 1 JULY 2012 AND VERSIONS DATED 1 JULY 2011

The most significant differences between the documents dated 1 July 2012 and those released July 2011 are outlined below. <u>This document does not represent a comprehensive list of every amendment incorporated in the versions dated 1 July 2012.</u>
