If agreement is not reached within one month after the notice seeking contribution is given, either of the parties involved can apply to the Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal (QCAT) for an order about the contributions for the fencing work under section 245XQ of the Building Act 1975. Such an application must be made within two months after the notice is given. In considering an application, the Tribunal will apply the rules relating to pool barriers on common boundaries set out in the Building Act 1975.
