Australian Bureau Statistics Building Approvals and the GST

Councils forward details of all building approvals issued, to the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) as part of the ABS Building Approvals collection, The contract values (value of work) are an important part of the collection and with the introduction of the GST it is necessary to specify whether to include or exclude the GST component. The ABS has determined that *inclusive* of GST should be the basis for reporting. Development Application Forms have been updated to clarify the reporting requirements.

Therefore, we need your help to ensure that the value of all building jobs, both residential and non-residential, is collected on a *GST inclusive* basis. We regard it as vital that everyone involved in the approvals process, especially your staff who assist in the completion of approvals forms, are made aware of this decision.
