### **Update on registration applications**

## State based registration - Local Government Association (LGA) reminder

Local councils who submitted a limited amount of documentation are reminded that further and complete documentation must be submitted by 31 March 2015.

### Resources and required documentation

The Evidence Guidelines outline the evidence sources that can be used to demonstrate capacity to comply with the National Regulatory Code.

There are also a number of documents that providers have to complete as part of the process including:

- [The Performance Outcomes 1 - 6 Workbook](#), which is used to collect metric information
- [Community Housing Asset Summary Report](#), which is used to collect asset information
- [Financial Performance Report](#), which is used to collect and report financial information.
