Amendments to the *Queensland Development Code - Part* 14 Fire Safety in Budget Accommodation Buildings

Purpose

The purpose of this Newsflash is to advise amendments to the *Queensland Development Code* (*QDC*) Part 14 Fire Safety in Budget Accommodation Buildings, will commence from <u>30 November 2007</u>.

Background

Newsflash 291 (7/11/07) advised of a proposed minor amendment to Part 14 to define "self closing doors".

Legislation

Building Act 1975 Building Regulation 2006

The term "self closing doors" has been defined to mean doors which are fitted with a device -

(a) with an *automatic*-closing operation initiated by the activation of the building's interconnected smoke alarms or smoke detection system; or

b) with a free-arm action closing operation which closes the door or causes the door to remain closed (without preventing manual re-opening), upon the detection of smoke by the building's interconnected smoke alarms or smoke detection system; or

(c) that returns the door to the fully closed position immediately after each opening.

Schedule 3 of the QDC Part 14 has also been amended to include the term self closing doors.
