IDAS Foundations Program

Rationale:

The course *Issuing Development Permits for Building Work* is a practice enhancement course specifically designed to enhance the competencies of certifiers practicing in Queensland. In doing so it is able to build on their existing skills and knowledge of the regulatory regime that operates in the State and, in particular, of the IDAS process.

For those not familiar with the Queensland system, the *IDAS Foundations Program* will provide an introduction to the workings of IDAS that will enable participants to better comprehend the material presented in the subsequent course in *Issuing Development Permits for Building Work*. The *IDAS Foundations Program* is not required as a prerequisite but is being offered at the request of a number of certifiers.

Content:

Session 1 – IDAS Overview. An introductory session to describe the purpose, scope and key concepts underpinning IDAS. The session will cover the basic process involved with IDAS.

Session 2 – IDAS Details.

This session will provide details of IDAS notices and timeframes as well as providing additional detail to some of the key stages of IDAS.

Duration:

The *IDAS Foundations Program* is of four hours duration and is to be conducted in the afternoon prior to the course *Issuing Development Permits for Building Work*.

(Note: The program will only be offered if sufficient registrations are received.)

Cost:

\$250 + GST

Status:

The *IDAS Foundations Program* does not form part of the requirements for registration as a *Private Certifier Class A*. There is no assessment requirement for attendees and participants will be issued with a *Certificate of Attendance*. Participants would need to verify with their professional institute as to whether attendance earns CPD points.
