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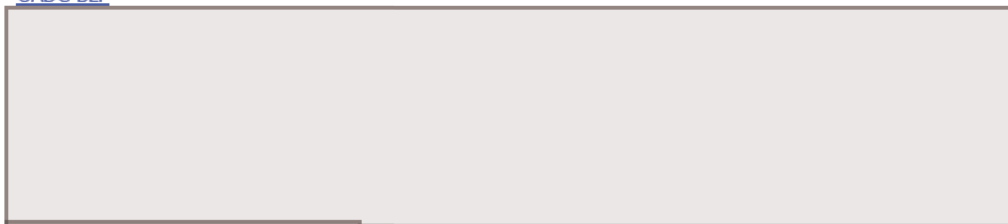

Many thanks for your email regarding the status of fire protection communications.


By way of update, the initial communications materials (as previously reviewed by your teams) were provided to the MO (Mel H) for approval last Friday. As per standard process, as soon as I receive advice that these are ok for release I will let you know and trigger the sequential release of materials (both by the Department and QBCC). I know that the Minister in particular likes to ensure that MCC members and those involved closely in developing any new policy are advised first.

I was concerned to learn that a presentation to external industry stakeholders last week following STC may have included fire protection material without the necessary approval or departmental awareness.

In terms of a joint briefing to the MO perhaps one on the broader fire protection licensing implementation as initially planned pre-caretaker would be a more suitable way forward?
