

#### Local leadership

 recognises locals know their communities, risks and needs best and that resilience champions at the local, regional and state level are needed to empower communities.

#### Flexibility and adaptation - adapt to the changing disaster context.

#### Shared responsibility and collaboration


 involves co-designed and co-delivered solutions, using multi-disciplinary approaches, with minimal impost on local resources.

#### Prioritisation

 refers to the right policy settings, the right location, and the right resources.

#### Resilience becomes business as usual

 embeds mainstream resilience into the 'day to day' through proactive (not reactive) approaches.
